

**INFORMATION ON PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH PURPOSES
(ART. 13 REG. UE 2016/679)**

COASTENERGY (in the following, “Project”):

Dear participant (in the following, Knowledge Provider- KP),

pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 and the subsequent national transposing laws (jointly, the "GDPR"), with this privacy information notice we wish to inform you about the processing of your personal data by the partners of the Project.

Aims and data flow of the Project

The project is led by IRENA – Istrian Regional Energy Agency and foresees the construction of a public gallery of skills and a geo-database portal aimed at fostering the deployment of Blue Energy in the Adriatic Sea and in the Mediterranean. This specific task is led by the University of Camerino (in the following, UNICAM), in collaboration with all Project partners.”

The procedure for the implementation of the portal are as follows: the KP will provide its data by filling in an online form. The manager of the platform will check and approve the form. Once approved, the KP data will appear in a public gallery and Web-GIS. The processing of KP data will be done through paper and electronic tools (publication on a digital platform). The KP will provide data that will be subject to approval by the Project coordinators. Data under approval cannot be changed. Data that have been approved will appear in a public gallery and in a web-GIS portal and can be updated again. Data that are being updated will be immediately blocked until they are approved again (in the meanwhile, the old ones will still be visible).

Purposes of data processing and storage

The processing of KP data is carried out for the realization of the scientific purposes of the Project. The Project has been drawn up according to the methodological standards of the related scientific sector and it is deposited at the School of Science and Technology of UNICAM, where it will be kept for three years from the planned conclusion of the Project.

If in the three years following the end of the COASTENERGY Project the School of Science and Technology of UNICAM participates in a new project with the same purposes, the KP data will be kept for the duration of the new project and for three years from its conclusion. In this case the KP will be contacted by e-mail.

Legal basis of data processing

The processing of KP personal data is carried out by UNICAM in the execution of his duties of public interest pursuant to art. 6, paragraph 1, lett. e) of the GDPR.

The treatment of particular categories of personal data (sensitive data) is carried out for scientific research purposes pursuant to art. 9, paragraph 2, lett. j) of the GDPR.

Category and type of personal data processed

The realization of the Project implies the treatment of the following personal data:

name of the company, address registration number, telephone number, e-mail, website; name of the person authorised for the registration, surname, position, telephone, e-mail; expertise, experiences, specific services offered by the company.

Methods of data processing

Your personal data shall be processed by UNICAM, as well as by any Project partner in accordance with the instructions provided by UNICAM, in order to carry out certain tasks of the Project or to conduct specific stages relating to the data processing, such as by way of example the allocation, management and maintenance of the electronic databases, or other supporting, instrumental and ancillary activities, such as the transmission of information and/or documents. In this case, the processor will provide sufficient guarantees to meet the requirements set forth by the applicable law provisions governing data processing, including all security-related provisions, also at technological level.

Data storage and retention

The KP personal data contained in the database for the purposes indicated in section “**Aims and data flow of the Project**” shall be stored and retained during the whole Project duration - unless the KP has submitted a specific and legitimate request for erasure - and at most up to 3 years after the end of the Project.

Motivation of provisioning data

The provision of the KP data for the aforementioned research purposes is essential for the development of the Project and does not derive from a regulatory and/or contractual obligation. Failure to provide such data determines the inability to participate in the Project.

Recipients of personal data and transfer of data to countries abroad

The KP personal data in the unapproved state will not be visible to the public and will only be visible to the Project partners (in a non-anonymous way) for acceptance. This data will not be disclosed to third parties. Once accepted, the data will be visible to the whole web.

Dissemination of research results

Statistical and/or scientific results will be disseminated (for example through the publication of scientific papers and/or the creation of databases, also with open access methods, participation in conferences, etc.) only in anonymous and/or aggregated way and in any case in ways that do not make the KP identifiable.

Rights of the KP

As an interested party, the KP can ask the data processing controller at any time for the exercise of rights described in the art.15 of GDPR and, in particular, access to their personal data, rectification, integration, deletion, limitation of processing that concerns them or to oppose their processing.

Pursuant to art. 17, paragraph 3, lett. d) the right to cancellation does not exist for data which must be elaborated for the purposes of scientific research if the objectives of the research itself cannot be obtained without them.
